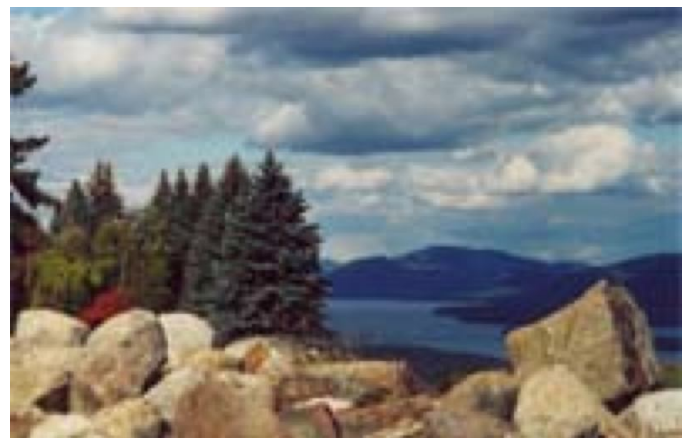

ACCOMMODATIONS

We are staying at the Fort William Henry Resort and Conference Center in Lake George, NY. Lake George's premiere, upscale, full service resort is located on the southern basin of the Queen of Lakes with spectacular views of Lake George. It is on an 18-acre estate that includes a restored Colonial Fortress. There is a fitness club, spa, outdoor Olympic size pool, indoor pool, Jacuzzi, and sauna. There is free parking and shuttle service is available.

Lake view rooms are limited. Send your reservation forms in early as it will be first-come, first-serve on the room assignments.

Also, some economy rooms might be available in a separate building. If you would be interested in an economy room with a savings of \$70 on a double package, there is a location on the reservation form (*in italics*) just below the package prices for you to indicate your interest. However, you need to send in payment for regular package price. If we are able to get economy rooms and assign you and a roommate to one, we will let you know and will refund you the \$70 difference at the convention.

The convention package includes your six nights stay at the Fort William Henry, six breakfasts, five dinners one of which is a dinner cruise, dances, daily Mass (except Wednesday), and parties including our welcome and after-hours parties.
