_____ Sunday, July 13, 2014 Tour of the City of Gatlinburg and Back roads of the area

Enjoy the countryside as we take to the “back roads” and learn the history of East Tennessee, including some of the traditions of the mountain people, the impact of the TVA upon the area, as well as one of the oldest towns in the state. Your tour guide will tell stories of moonshine and see some of the country where “white lightning” was brewed. Bring your camera for beautiful scenic views of the rural areas. 4 hours

Enjoy a 3.5 hour journey to the upper reaches of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. You will experience some of the most spectacular panoramic views of the Smokies. Visit the Sugarland Visitor’s Center, beautiful mountain overlooks, and Newfound Gap where Roosevelt dedicated the National Park in 1940. Travel to elevations of 5,048 feet. Your guide will give you the history of the park along with information about the area wildlife and legends of the region. 3.5 hours

First settled in 1818, this tour is a trip back into the history of the area. Cades Cove is one of the most visited places in the park and the best place to view wildlife within the park. 5 hours
