_____ \$38.00 Sunday, July 8, 12:00 noon to 3:00 pm - **Charm City Tour*** – Hear stories and anecdotes of some Baltimore personalities; get an overview of many landmarks and neighborhoods, including such places as Little Italy, Mt. Vernon (and the first Washington Monument!), Fells Point, Edgar Allan Poe grave, Babe Ruth birthplace, Baltimore Basilica, and more!

_____ \$38.00 Monday, July 9, 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm - **Charm City Tour*** – (Repeat of Sunday tour)

_____ \$ 5.00 + Tuesday, July 10, 11:30 am - 2:15 pm – **Baltimore Basilica Mass (12:10) & Tour (1:00 pm)** - America’s First Cathedral! Tour the upper church, undercroft, Our Lady Seat of Wisdom Chapel, Crypt, and St John Paul II Prayer Garden. The tour will follow the 12:10 pm Mass at the Basilica; no Mass at the hotel on this day. **Transportation** will be coordinated from/to the hotel with at least 2 options – ranging from no cost (such as the free Charm City Circulator) **to \$6-20** round trip (such as by cab, shared cab). It is less than 1 mile.

_____ \$18.00 Tuesday, July 10. 3:45 pm – 4:45 pm – **Baltimore Harbor Cruise** – a 45 minute city tour from the water side, with open upper deck and lower climate controlled deck. Travel out to Fort McHenry and back, and see sights not easily seen from land, and learn some history. The boat leaves promptly at 4:00 pm, don’t be late! (The boat is across the street from the hotel, we will coordinate groups to get there.)

_____ \$74.00 Wednesday, July 11, 8:00 am – 6:00 pm – **Annapolis Adventure*** – (lunch included)
Visit the U.S. Naval Academy, including Bancroft Hall (largest single dormitory in the world) and the Naval Academy Chapel with the crypt of John Paul Jones. We will lunch at the academy before continuing on to the Maryland State House – the oldest continually used state house in the country served as the capital of the United States 1783-1784, and has the largest wooden dome of its kind in the U.S. The Charles Carroll House, home to three generations and a founding father and a history spanning over 300 years, is on the grounds of St Mary’s church, among the largest and most impressive historic sites in Annapolis. The Carrolls were among the most prominent Catholics in the English colonies.

_____ \$36.00 Wednesday, July 11, 7:05 pm – **Yankees vs Orioles baseball** – Oriole Park at Camden Yards is only 3 blocks from our hotel, so why not go to a baseball game? Our group tickets (lower reserve, outfield) require a minimum of 15, and confirmed (paid) reservations are DUE BY MAY 25. The ball park is 3 blocks from hotel.

_____ \$48.00 Thursday, July 12, 11:45 am – 3:45 pm – **Star Spangled City Tour*** – *O, Say Can You See?* See Fort McHenry, where Francis Scott Key watched the battle from a ship in the Harbor, and at dawn’s early light on September 14, 1814, saw the flag still flying. Then, on to the Flag House and Museum, home of Mary Pickersgill, commissioned to sew the garrison flag, and a short visit to the Francis Scott Key Memorial.

_____ \$ 9.00 Friday, July 13, 9:00 am -11:00 am – **Oriole Park at Camden Yards** - Oriole Park revolutionized baseball when it debuted on Opening Day 1992. Now, here's your chance to go behind the scenes of this historic ballpark and learn more about how it has continued to change the baseball fan's experience ever since. Walking tour, but the Park tour is accessible to all; please inquire about accommodations. Most will meet in the hotel lobby between 8:45-9:00 am to walk 3 blocks to the Park for tour start.

_____ \$48.00 Friday, July 13, 12:15 pm – 4:15 pm – **Catholic Heritage Tour*** – including the Mother Seton House and historic Seminary Chapel (1808) (first seminary in America), St. Vincent de Paul Church - oldest continuously used parish church (1840) in Baltimore, St Mary’s Seminary and the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen in north Baltimore, and sites along the way. (Tour start may shift by 15-30 min.)
