There is a wonderful one-hour guided tour.

Detroit's own Father Solanus Casey was beatified on Nov. 18, 2017. Visit the Fr. Solanus Casey Center and the museum at St. Bonaventure Monastery and learn about this very humble man.

The Henry Ford Museum is America's greatest history destination and is only minutes away (with the hotel shuttle) as well as Greenfield Village with its 90 historic buildings, period presenters and artisans. Watch the action of the real-life factory floor where the Ford F-150 is made on the Ford Rouge Factory tour.

The Detroit Zoo's new Polk Penguin Conservation Center is the largest penguin facility in the world. And of course there are the museums. In the Cultural Center you will find the Detroit Institute of Arts, the Detroit Historical Museum, the Science museum and the Museum of African American History all within a short walk of each other.
